## Code of Conduct – Donors (Businesses, Organizations, or Individuals)

### Purpose

This Code of Conduct outlines expectations for businesses, organizations, and individuals who donate to or sponsor the Peculiar Parks Foundation.

### Respect & Integrity

Donors are expected to:

- Engage with the Foundation in good faith
- Treat Board members, volunteers, staff, and partners with respect
- Support the Foundation's mission and community focus

### Donations & Influence

Donations to the Foundation:

- Do not guarantee influence over Foundation decisions
- Do not provide authority over project selection, governance, or expenditures
- May not be used to exert pressure on Board members or operations

### Transparency

Donors shall:

- Accurately represent their intent when making donations
- Disclose any expectations or restrictions at the time of donation
- Acknowledge that restricted donations are subject to Board approval

## **Conduct Standards**

Donors shall not:

- Engage in behavior that is disruptive, coercive, or inappropriate
- Attempt to influence Board decisions through improper means
- Use association with the Foundation to misrepresent endorsement or control

## **Use of Name & Recognition**

Use of the Foundation's name, logo, or association must be approved in advance and used only as authorized.

## **Violations**

The Foundation reserves the right to decline, revoke, or return donations and discontinue donor relationships if conduct violates this Code or undermines the Foundation's integrity.
