Code of Conduct – Members (Future Membership Program)

Purpose

This Code of Conduct establishes expectations for individuals or organizations participating as members of the Peculiar Parks Foundation.

Community Engagement

Members are expected to:

- Support the mission and values of the Foundation
- Engage positively with the community and fellow members
- Act in a manner that reflects well on the Foundation

Respectful Conduct

Members shall:

- Treat others with courtesy and professionalism
- Refrain from harassment, discrimination, or abusive behavior
- Respect diversity of opinions and backgrounds

Ethical Participation

Members shall not:

- Misrepresent their role or authority within the Foundation
- Use membership status for personal or financial gain
- Engage in activities that conflict with the Foundation's mission

Communications

Members shall:

- Communicate honestly and respectfully
- Avoid spreading misinformation about the Foundation
- Follow established guidelines for public communications

Compliance

Members must comply with:

- Applicable Foundation policies
- Event, program, or participation guidelines
- Local, state, and federal laws

Violations

Violation of this Code may result in suspension or termination of membership at the discretion of the Foundation.
